

COVID-19 RELATED EXPENSES MAY BE DEDUCTIBLE IF DIRECTLY RELATED TO WORK

Quarantine Expenses

If you are required to quarantine either during or after a work trip, you can claim a tax deduction for the related expenses.

Test Expenses

A COVID-19 test may be required for you to enter an overseas country or state and for you to return to Australia or your home state. The cost of a COVID-19 test is therefore considered to be an incidental expense as the travel is undertaken in the course of your employment.

If you are required to return a negative Covid19 test before returning to the workplace, the cost of purchasing the test is also tax deductible.

Personal Protective Equipment

The cost of face masks, gloves, sanitiser and anti-bacterial spray may also be deductible depending on your work duties. Refer to the following ATO Link for more details:

Fringe benefit tax will also not be incurred by employers if they provide COVID-19 tests to their employees for work-related purposes.

These deductions are available for the entire 2021-22 tax year and will be in place permanently.
